Your direct English pathway to a Griffith University degree, Study Abroad or Exchange program, or a Griffith College program.

Direct Entry Program

Join our highly popular Direct Entry Program to gain the English skills necessary to enter a Griffith University degree or a program at Griffith College.

There are seven levels in the Direct Entry program and you will be placed in the appropriate class for you based on your proficiency test or your Griffith English Test result.

In our classes, you will use technology to access your learning materials and complete your class work.

In the Direct Entry Program, you will build your English language skills in Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking, and at the higher levels you will practise academic skills that will help you to be successful in your future studies.

When you successfully complete the Direct Entry Program at the equivalent of the IELTS level needed for your degree or diploma, you can enter your program directly without needing to submit a proficiency test result.*

General English

Our English courses are not just for people wanting to go to university. We know there is a variety of reasons you may want to improve your English.

No matter whether you are beginner or advanced, you can enrol in our General English program to achieve your goals. You will receive all the benefits of studying on the Griffith University campus and have access to leading student support services and activities.

If you change your study preferences and decide that you would like to apply to Griffith University or Griffith College at a later date, you will already be on the pathway to undertake further study.

GELI classes

Class sizes at GELI are small so you will receive personal attention from your teachers and progress quickly through your studies.

There are 20 hours of study per week, plus an additional 5 hours of independent learning each week using GELI's independent learning plans. You will need a laptop with camera and microphone to access learning resources and for some class activities.

Classes are held daily Monday to Friday in two 2-hour sessions with a break between the sessions.

Accommodation

Whether you would like to live on-campus or off-campus, there are several options you can explore to find housing to suit your needs. You can also choose homestay and live with a local Australian family while you study.

Off-campus

You may wish to organise your long-term off-campus accommodation after you arrive in Australia to ensure you are choosing a suitable living and study environment.

Griffith offers a preferred partnership program with a selection of off-campus accommodation providers. Providers are located close to our Gold Coast and Nathan campuses.

On-campus

On-campus accommodation is available at our Gold Coast and Nathan campuses. On-campus accommodation is usually fully furnished and provides access to cooking facilities, laundry facilities, gym equipment, common rooms and internet.

Homestay

Homestay accommodation gives you the option of living with an Australian family while you study. Homestay is available to students at all Griffith campuses. Some homestay providers offer independent living options such as a granny flat. Homestay is a great way to develop your English language skills and experience life in Australia, and offers catered and self-catered options.

Have a friendly face to meet you at the airport when you arrive in Australia! GELI offers a free airport pickup service from the Brisbane and Gold Coast airports to take you directly to your pre-arranged accommodation.

Cost of living

South East Queensland is an affordable and friendly place to study and offers a combination of quality education and high living standards.

The cost of living in South East Queensland is considered more affordable than other major Australian cities such as Sydney and Melbourne*.

The Australian Government requires students to have access to a minimum of AUD \$21,041 (Australian dollars) per year to meet their living costs, and more if they will have family members accompanying them.

*In the QS Best Student Cities 2022 rankings, Brisbane and the Gold Coast are ahead of Sydney and Melbourne in the Affordability Rank.



- provide information about Orientation;
- send you a series of emails with information to assist your transition to study at GELI.
