怀特 (Waite) 校区

独立住宿学院

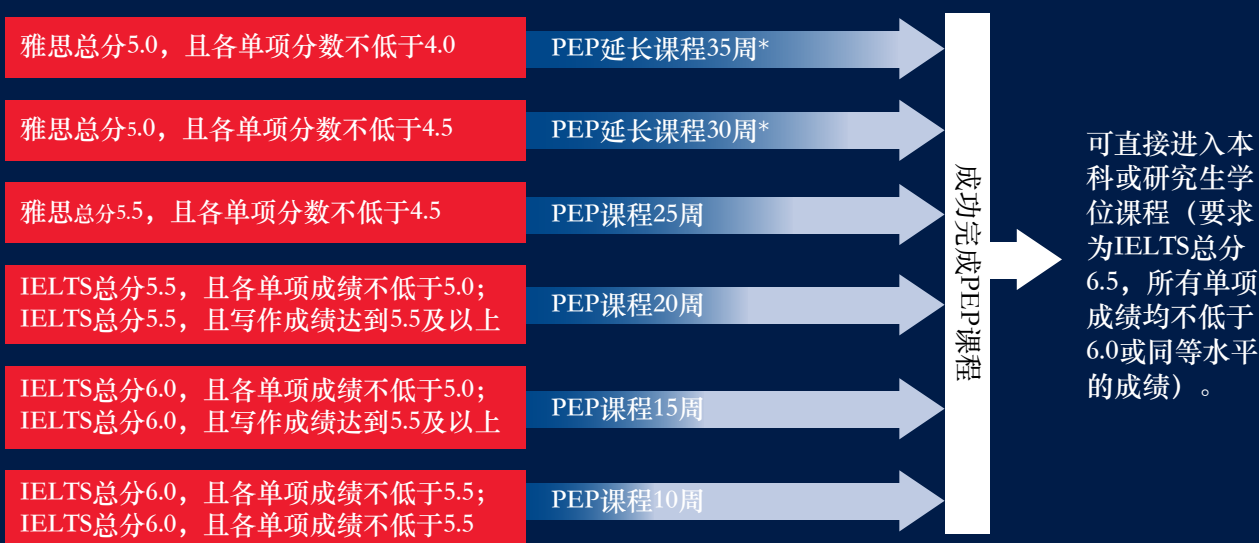

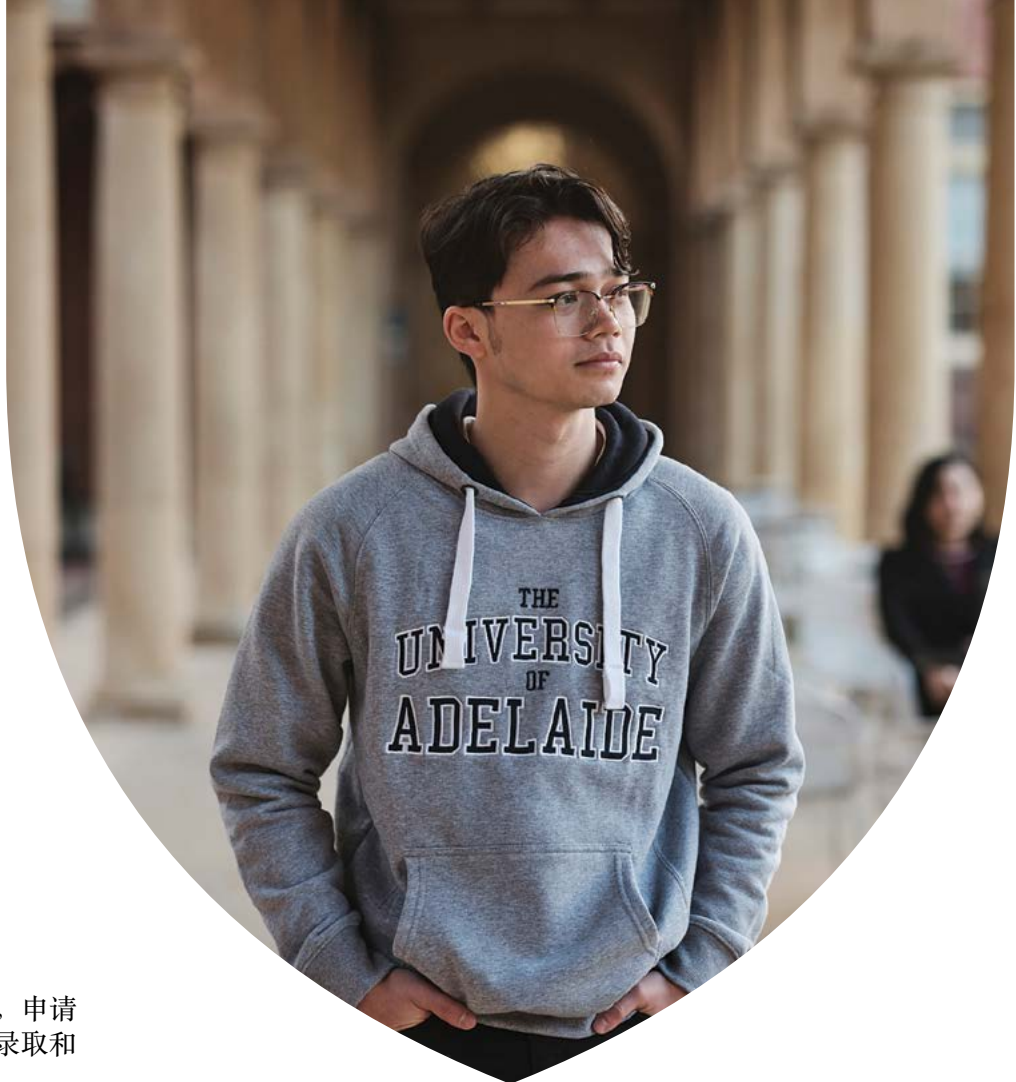

荣誉学士学位是一项为期一年的全日制(或非全日制同等周期)课程,允许学生通过研究和论文巩固本科阶段的学习。

雅思

国际英语语言测试系统是一项国际公认的英国英语语言评估测试,对学生签证要求至关重要。

指导性学费(每年)

本说明书中引用的指导性学费(年)是根据每年24学分或每学期12学分的标准全日制学习工作量计算的。这些费用包括教学费用和学生支持服务费用。所列费用每年进行一次审核。未来的学生需要知道他们的费用每年都会增加,并且他们在接受录取通知书后需要承担这些费用。录取通知书会告知每位学生他们的学费计划。费用可能因入学工作量而异,例如:如果学生“超负荷”或“工作量不足”,费用可能相应增加或减少。所有费用均以澳元(AUD\$)计算。

讲座

由一位讲师针对一个特定主题向大班学生授课的课程。

级别

学位的一个阶段或一段时间的学习(通常为一年),例如1级、2级、3级。课程的深度和复杂程度在每个级别都有所提高。

专业组合

经过批准的作为一个领域内专业方向的课程组合,可以在一年或数年内完成。

海外学生健康保险

海外学生健康保险是强制性健康保险,提供基本和紧急健康保险。它是留学生获得学生签证是一项基本要求。

非全日制学习

任何学习工作量低于75%,或每年18个学分。请注意,根据现行的学生签证规定,不建议留学生进行非全日制学习,因为澳大利亚内务部要求他们在指定的学位期限内完成学业。

学术英语直升入学课程(PEP)

为没有达到所选专业入学要求的学生提供的直接入学途径的英语语言课程。

先决条件

为了获得某些专业的入学资格,特别是在科学、工程、数学和计算机科学领域,申请人必须通过称为先决条件的特定科目。

课程

构成特定学历的一系列课程,例如:商学士。

高考排名分

为某个专业设定并作为招生流程的一部分所使用的分数。

学期

单个课程的标准长度。大学课程分两个学期授课:第一学期从2月/3月至6月下旬,第二学期从7月/8月至11月。

讨论课

类似于辅导课的小型课程,包括学生的演讲。

托福考试(TOEFL)

作为外语的英语考试,一项总部设在美国的国际公认的英语考试。

辅导课

由助教或讲师主持的每周小型课程,学生在该课程中讨论与特定课程相关的问题。

学分

一个分配给课程的值,用来确定所涉及的工作量。全日制学生通常每年学习24个学分。
